There are many different ways to get stuff and information you need; some of the things are specific, like interviews, photographs or drawings, but with others, you can be as creative as you like.

1. Take a photo with Steamer the Clam at Clam Fest and a photo at a real marine habitat in town. Share on-line, print and paste below, or draw a map of the location you visited to see where real clams live in town. 2. Find your home on the <u>Town zoning map</u> and find a current map of the town or state that shows the location of Yarmouth. Copy and paste an image of the zoning map from on-line. Earn 2 bonus points if you visit the library and find an image of an old map of Yarmouth! Share a selfie or paste a photo of the map below.



3. Find 5 buildings in town that have all been built at different times before 1940. Draw pictures or take photographs of each. Earn bonus points for each different architectural style you find too!



4. Visit the Yarmouth History Center and take a picture of your favorite item in the museum. Share the photo and explain why below. Earn 5 bonus points if you become a History Center member too!



5. Visit Yarmouth's conserved lands and find 5 leaves from 5 different trees in town. You can paste them below or do leaf rubbings using crayons and this paper. Check out the maps on planyarmouth.com or the draft Inventory Chapter 7-Marine Resources and Chapter 8-Natural Resources to find conserved open spaces in town and learn more!



6. Make a meal only from foods at the Yarmouth Farmers Market. Earn 2 bonus points if you visit the Yarmouth Community Garden to find those same vegetables or fruits, and earn 5 bonus points if you make a food donation to the Yarmouth Food Pantry.
